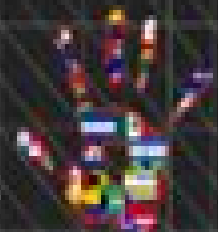
Society

- People belong to informal and formal groups, and within and between these groups there are patterns of interactions that contribute to unique cultures.

Culture

- Culture refers to the shared knowledge, attitudes and behaviours that generate reality, to all norms, values and distinctive way of life.
- Culture is demonstrated by the values, customs, values, norms, traditions, general ideas, art, technology and **artefacts** that people generate and learn as they interact in a group or community and allow group to exist, survive and thrive.
- Culture is dynamic and is subject to change, and is inherited and social.



Definition:
