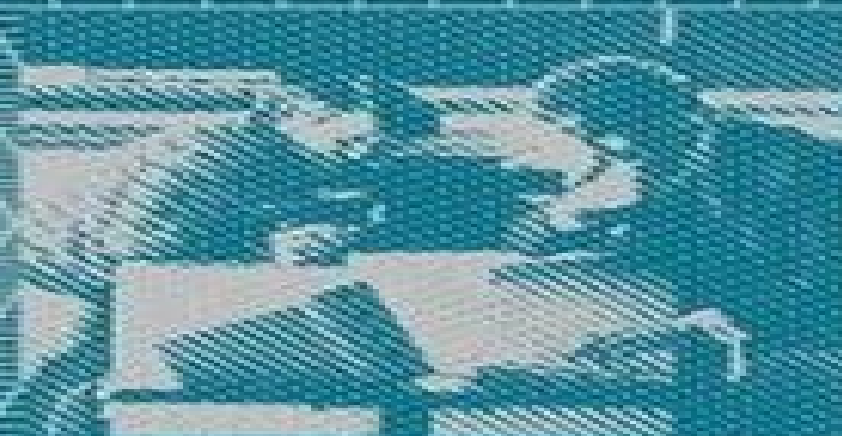

In a penetrating analysis of highly successful ventures, the author reveals the importance of strategically transforming the company to a market oriented focus and he examines the widespread tendency even among the most successful high tech firms to displace the founder before the company achieves super success.
