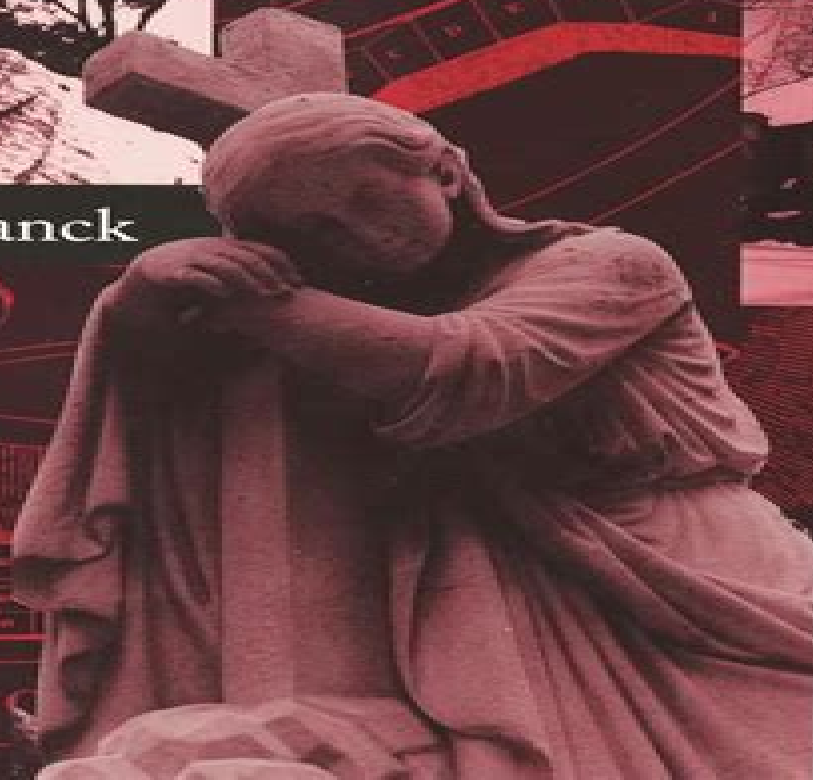

risen to the pinnacle of his career Together with his partners stepson John Charles Olmsted and protégé Henry Sargent Codman he was involved in a number of major ongoing projects including the Boston Buffalo and Rochester park systems the campus plan for Stanford University and numerous private estates In July he reported that the firm had twenty works of considerable importance underway including nine large parks and six estates that he believed were matters of public interest Before the summer ended the firm's commitments would expand dramatically as Olmsted and his partners were appointed landscape architects for the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago As commissions for new park systems residential communities grounds for educational institutions and private homes increased Olmsted feared that their commitments would exceed the partners ability to do their best work Despite these fears Olmsted's work in the final six years of his professional career would only enhance his considerable reputation as the ninth and final volume of *The Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted* reveals With its impressive waterways monumental buildings and verdant islands and shores the Chicago fair proved to be one of the firm's crowning achievements The early 1890s also saw the culmination of Olmsted's wide ranging work on one of his other great projects the design of the grounds of George W Vanderbilt's massive estate Biltmore near Asheville North Carolina In planning the estate's thousands of acres Olmsted outlined new approaches to landscape design promoted the creation of the first scientific forestry operation in the United States designed a model residential subdivision and proposed an arboretum that would have been the most ambitious in the nation *The Last Great Projects 1890-1895* chronicles the history of one of the world's greatest landscape design firms while offering a fascinating retrospective on Frederick Law Olmsted's productive final years The volume also gathers together the important documents of this last triumphant era As Olmsted neared the end of his career he wrote some of his most reflective letters and reports summarizing the legacy of his involvement with the U S Sanitary Commission the quality of landscape design in England and France the biographical circumstances that proved most important to his development as an artist and his hopes and fears for the future of his profession

means to a self determined life Among these people are visionaries who not only survived against the odds but prospered building businesses owning land and other property Freedom by Any Means also features the return of many of the beloved figures from her previous book Forbidden Fruit including Lucy Nichols Al and Margaret Wood and Sylvia and Louis Stark This inspiring account steeped in rich historical research attests to the resolve of the human spirit and reveals how men and women were willing to risk it all to escape the slavery

A Hanging in Detroit David G. Chardavoyne,2003 On September 24 1830 Stephen G Simmons a fifty year old tavern keeper and farmer was hanged in Detroit for murdering his wife Levana Simmons in a drunken jealous rage Michigan executed only two people during the fifty year period from 1796 to 1846 when the death penalty was legal within its boundaries Simmons was the second and last person to be executed under Michigan law In A Hanging in Detroit David G Chardavoyne vividly evokes not only the crime trial and execution of Simmons but also the setting and players of the drama social and legal customs of the times and the controversy that arose because of the affair Chardavoyne illuminates his account of this important moment in Michigan s history with many little known facts creating a study that is at once an engrossing story and the first historical examination of the event that helped bring about the abolition of the death penalty in Michigan Simmons execution came at a time when Michigan had begun to change from a sparsely populated wilderness to a thriving agricultural center and Detroit from a small military outpost to a metropolis founded on trade manufacturing and an influx of immigrants and other settlers The hanging was a defining moment during this period of dramatic social change Thousands of spectators crowded into Detroit expecting to see a thrilling public execution Many of those spectators however left deeply disturbed by the spectacle they had witnessed Chardavoyne a lawyer probes the unsettling incident which sparked a profound shift in attitudes toward capital punishment in Michigan examining along the way such mysteries as why Simmons was hanged for his crime when other contemporary killers were hardly punished at all A Hanging in Detroit will fascinate legal historians and lay readers alike with its incisive look into Great Lakes regional history and crime and punishment in Michigan

traditions have remained strong despite major world events that shook Detroit such as Prohibition the Great Depression and World War II In looking at The Players of today Levering explores the camaraderie and sense of history that has kept the club together and relatively unchanged throughout the years She also examines the club's notable members and its unique place in Detroit history Detroit on Stage places The Players club in the broader contexts of social clubs explaining how these organizations originate and function Readers interested in Detroit cultural history and theater studies will enjoy this rare glimpse inside a long standing Detroit cultural institution

was one of the partly judicial partly governmental municipal units combining contradictory aristocratic and democratic traditions into which the province was divided until 1850. With its substantial French Canadian population and its veneer of British officialdom in close proximity to a newly American outpost the Western District was potentially the most unstable. Despite all however Alan Douglas demonstrates that the Western District endured without apparent change longer than any of the others.

Enterprising Images John Vincent Jezierski, 2000. The story of the most prolific African American photographers in North America. From its beginnings in York Pennsylvania in 1847 until the death of Wallace L Goodridge in Saginaw Michigan in 1922 the Goodridge Brothers Studio was the most significant and enduring African American photographic establishment in North America. In *Enterprising Images* John Vincent Jezierski tells the story of one of America's first families of photography documenting the history of the Goodridge studio for three quarters of a century. The existence of more than one thousand Goodridge photographs in all formats and the family's professional and personal activism enrich the portrait that emerges of this extraordinary family. Weaving photographic and regional history with the narrative of a family whose lives paralleled the social and political happenings of the country Jezierski provides the reader with a complex family biography for those interested in regional and African American as well as photographic history.

More than seventy sheet music covers dating from between 1890 and 1955 are interposed with the narrative adding to the book's charm and historic value.

Angels in the Architecture Heidi Johnson, 2004-02-20. An intimate photographic journey into 115 years of history inside a nineteenth century asylum. In the nineteenth century perhaps no approach to mental illness was more compassionate than that of hospital administrator Thomas Story Kirkbride whose asylum designs integrated beauty and nature as a method to treat patients. The Northern Michigan Asylum in Traverse City Michigan was one of the last of nearly two hundred such architecturally intriguing asylums. Founded in 1885 under the principle beauty is therapy the Northern Michigan Asylum closed in 1989 and today stands as a haunting reminder of this lost era. *Angels in the Architecture* is a photographic study of this institution's one hundred year history. Heidi Johnson's photographs of the building today are juxtaposed with rare images from private collections and state archives. Johnson has captured Kirkbride's spirit of compassion of angels in the architecture in a book that conveys the human element of mental illness with beauty and integrity.

Fired Magic Marcy Heller Fisher, 2003. Mary Chase Perry Stratton and Horace J Caulkins founded Detroit's Pewabic Pottery in 1903 during the height of the Arts and Crafts Movement. Now celebrating its centennial Pewabic is one of the few historic art potteries still operating in the United States. The pottery
