Bengali bourgeoisie at that time I was provoked to write the history of the peasants glorious role in the Liberation Struggle which was being overshadowed by claims and counter claims of heroism and sacrifice by members of the privileged parasitical urban elites This work may be regarded as a prelude to the history of the freedom struggle that eventually led to the creation of Bangladesh This is an attempt to shed light on the peasant politics almost synonymous with Muslim politics in the region during the significant period between 1920 and 1947 when East Bengal was going through the political process that culminated in the creation of East Pakistan in 1947
