Manliness in these accounts was achieved through self control over passions such as lust anger and greed

It was also gained through manly displays of courage the endurance of pain and death on behalf of others

From Paul's early letters to the Gospels and Acts to the book of Revelation Christian writings in the Bible confront the potentially emasculating scandal of the cross and
