concentrates on Grant's boyhood and early married life his moral ethical and religious views his troubled military career his strained relationships with wartime superiors and especially his weakness for alcohol which exerted a major influence on both his military and civilian careers Longacre to a degree that no other historian has done before investigates Grant s alcoholism in light of his devout religious affiliations and the role these sometimes conflicting forces had on his military career and conduct Longacre's conclusions present a new and surprising perspective on the ever fascinating life of General Life and Campaigns of General U.S. Grant Phineas Camp Headley, 1868 Moltke and his Generals Quintin Barry, 2015-06-19 When Helmuth von Moltke took over as Chief of the Prussian General Staff the Prussian army had not fought for more than forty years Yet within a decade and a half he had brought it to the point where it was the strongest in Europe His successes on the battle field led to his methods being painstakingly analyzed by commentators and slavishly imitated by Western armies His success was not only due to far sighted strategic planning the comprehensive reorganization of the General Staff and his grasp of new technologies it was also due to his leadership of a talented if disparate group of subordinates even if some of them sometimes failed to grasp his overall intentions This book examines these key relationships Foremost among these was his collaboration with the able though choleric Karl Leonhard von Blumenthal their correspondence reflected every aspect of their campaigns He was also close to the Crown Prince whose aide de camp he had been Moltke was Chief of Staff to Prince Frederick Charles in Denmark in 1864 his admiration for the Red Prince was perhaps not maintained when the latter's caution caused problems Albrecht von Stosch Intendant General in 1870 1871 proved brilliantly successful when he had the chance to demonstrate his talents in the field Edwin von Manteuffel on whose recommendation Moltke was appointed was at the centre of Prussian politics for a decade and a half before becoming a successful army commander in 1866 and 1870 1871 Perhaps the most talented of Moltke's subordinates was August von Goeben a successful commander in all three wars of German unification August von Werder never enjoyed Moltke s confidence to the same extent but was extremely reliable On the other hand both Eduard Vogel von Falckenstein and Karl von Steinmetz caused Moltke considerable difficulty by their stubborn disobedience of his explicit orders Behind these relationships there existed the vital rapport which Moltke had with their Chiefs of Staff and his own general staff officers It was on his ability to rely on these men to execute his intentions that his success ultimately depended Theophil von Podbielski Julius Verdy du Vernois and Paul Bronsart von Schellendorf were some of the brilliant individuals who constituted one of the most powerful teams in military history Lincoln, the Cabinet, and the Generals Chester G. Hearn, 2010-04-01 While numerous accounts exist of President Abraham Lincoln's often troubled dealings with either his cabinet or his generals Chester G Hearn's illuminating history provides the first broad synthesis of Lincoln's complex relationship with both groups As such it casts new light on much of the behind the scenes interplay intrigue and sparring between the president and his advisors and military commanders during the most precarious years of the Civil War Turning first to Lincoln s cabinet Hearn

explains that Lincoln exercised a unique decision making process he reached a firm conclusion on an issue but then he debated it endlessly with his cabinet or generals as if still undecided To ensure the liveliest discourse Lincoln appointed as his advisors men with widely differing political motivations. The Republican Lincoln spent four years attempting to bring together his cabinet of former Whigs and Democrats in the spirit of cooperation but he never completely achieved his purpose Hearn explores the president's relationship with this cabinet the problems he encountered selecting it and the difficulties he experienced attempting to maintain ideological balance while trying to maneuver around those who disagreed with him Lincoln never broached a subject that did not create some level of dissent within the cabinet and differences in political philosophy and personal rivalries led to great debate over the running of the administration the selection of generals foreign relations and military mobilization emancipation freedom of the press civil rights and other issues Still Hearn asserts Lincoln's ability to navigate internal scuffles and external turmoil helped to define his presidency Hearn next demonstrates convincingly that even with these difficulties Lincoln manipulated his cabinet far more adroitly than he did his generals Many of Lincoln's top military commanders had political aspirations or agendas of their own while others were close friends of his intransigent cabinet members Having assumed the role as de facto army chief Lincoln took responsibility for the mishandling of battles fought by his generals some of whom were incompetent and unmanageable politicians Hearn examines the often disastrous generalship and its impact on Lincoln and the cabinet as well as the public the press and Congress Based on over a decade of research Lincoln the Cabinet and the Generals offers both a fresh perspective on and a new interpretation of Lincoln's presidency one that reveals the leadership genius as well as the imperfections of America's sixteenth president
