his profession was that of journalist Novels like Kipps and The History of Mr Polly which describe lower middle class life led to the suggestion when they were published that he was a worthy successor to Charles Dickens but Wells described a range of social strata and even attempted in Tono Bungay 1909 a diagnosis of English society as a whole A diabetic in 1934 Wells co founded the charity The Diabetic Association known today as Diabetes UK Classic Science Fiction Stories H.
