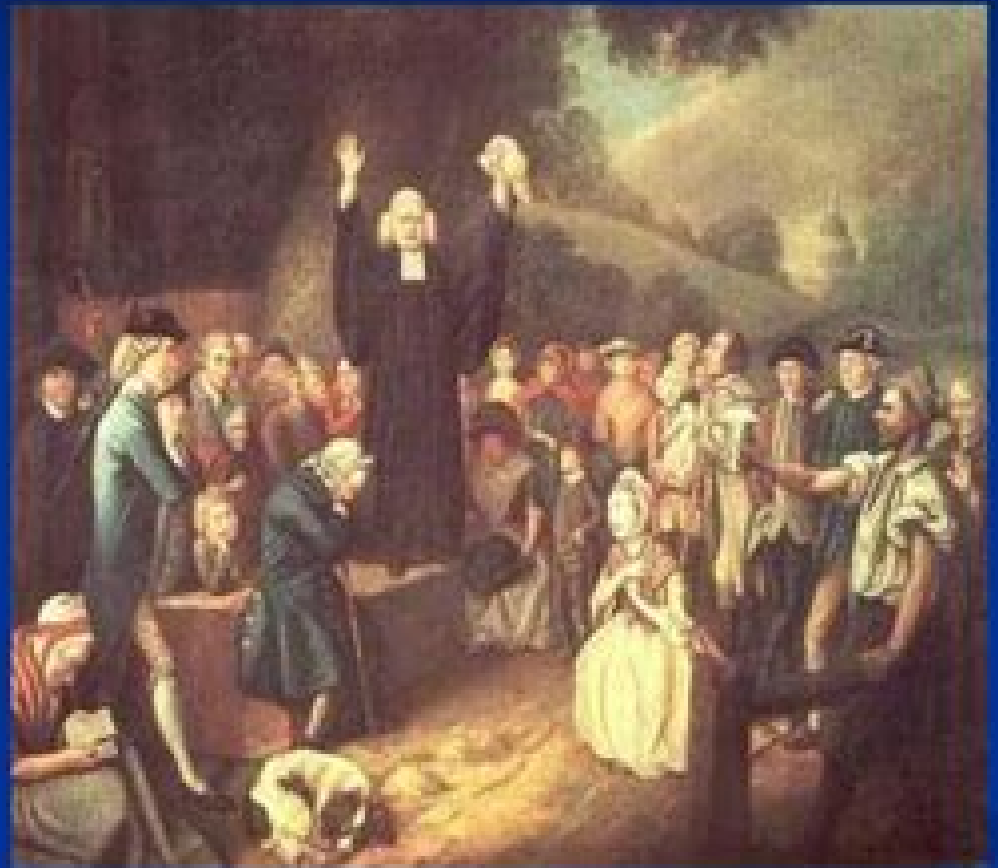


The Great Awakening
