militarization of Indigenous territory throughout the U S Mexico bordered lands The gathering and years of ensuing resistance and activism produced an archive of scholarly analyses testimonios artwork legal briefs poetry and other cultural productions This unique collection spotlights powerful voices and perspectives from Nd leaders Indigenous elders settler allies Native youth and others associated with the Tamez family the Nd defiance and the larger Indigenous rights movement to document their resistance expose confront and end racism and militarization and to foreground Indigenous women led struggles for justice
