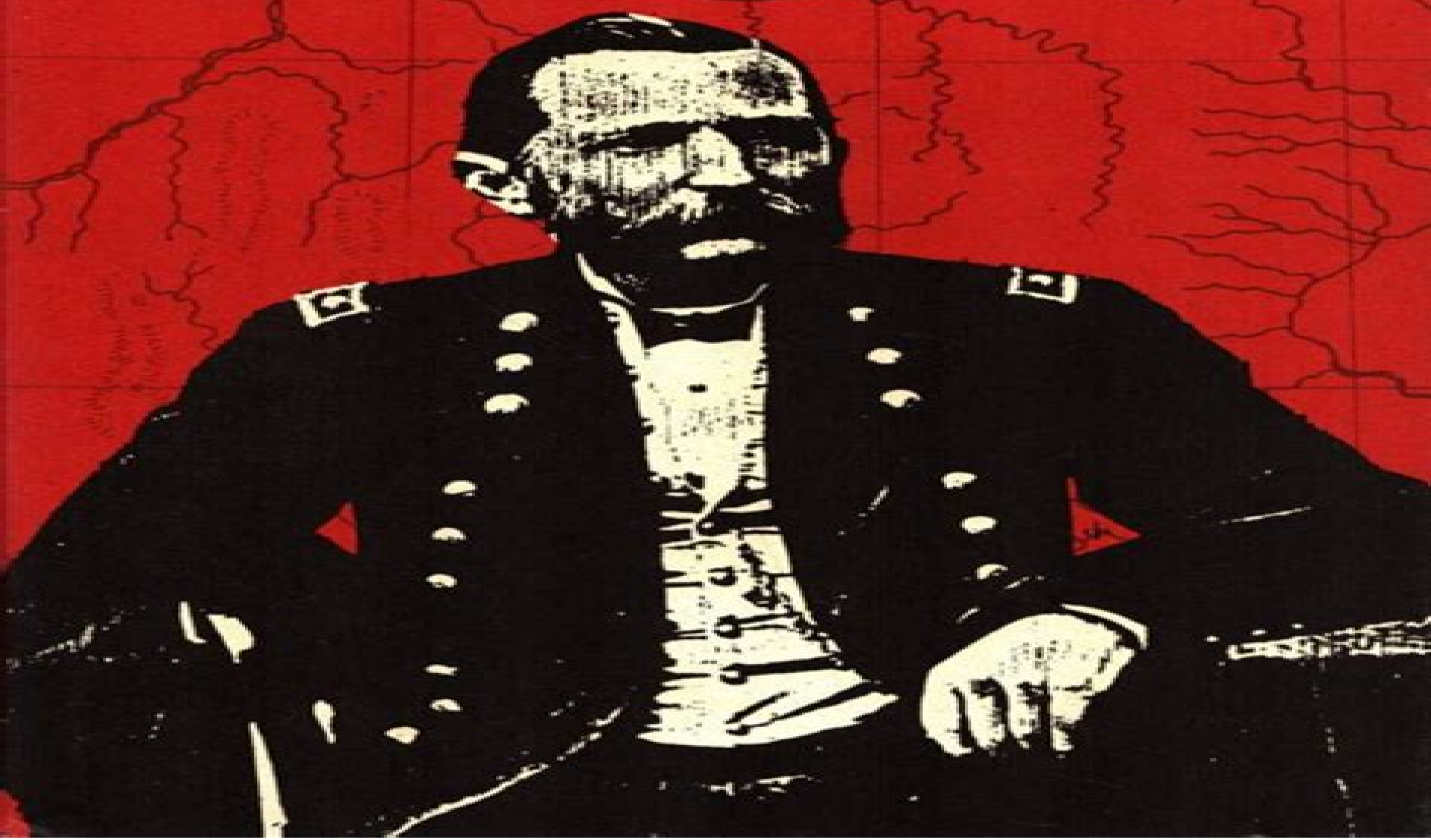

and the doctrine of blood atonement the church leadership eventually rejected his views Yet on the whole Brigham Young emerges as a multifaceted human figure and as a prophet revered by millions of LDS members an inspired leader who successfully led his people to a distant land where their community expanded and flourished Beyond the American Pale David M.
