God and Human Suffering Douglas John Hall, 1986 Professor Hall has written a major work on an agonizing subject at once brilliant comprehensive and thought provoking In contrast to many writers who gloss over one or the other Dr Hall is true both to the reality of suffering and to the affirmation that God creates sustains and redeems Creative is his view that certain aspects of what we call suffering loneliness experience of limits temptation anxiety are necessary parts of God's good creation These he distinguishes from suffering after the fall the tragic dimension of life Unique is his structure creation suffering as becoming the fall suffering as a burden redemption conquest from within Professor Hall succeeds in moving the reader beyond the customary way of stating the problem How can undeserved suffering coexist with a just and almighty God He also evaluates five popular leading thinkers on suffering Harold Kushner C S Lewis Diogenes Allen George Buttrick and Leslie Weatherhead *A Theology of the Cross* Charles B. Cousar, 1990-05-01 In Paul's epistles the crucifixion story reveals a God who is free and in no way bound by human categories or expectations Yet God in Christ chooses to be engaged in the very depths of the human predicament The message of the crucifixion is that God's power is manifested in weakness not in strength The author believes that this weakness as strength should be the focal point of the church's identity However a celebration of weakness is in complete opposition to traditional American beliefs in personal strength and a powerful church

The Theology of the Cross in Historical Perspective Anna M.
