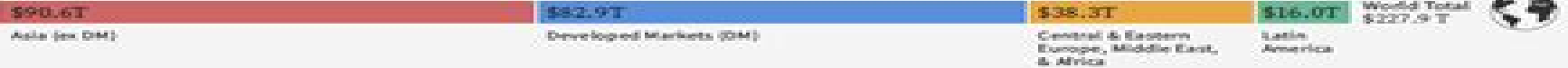


The Global Economy in 2050

Real GDP in 2050 (USD trillions)

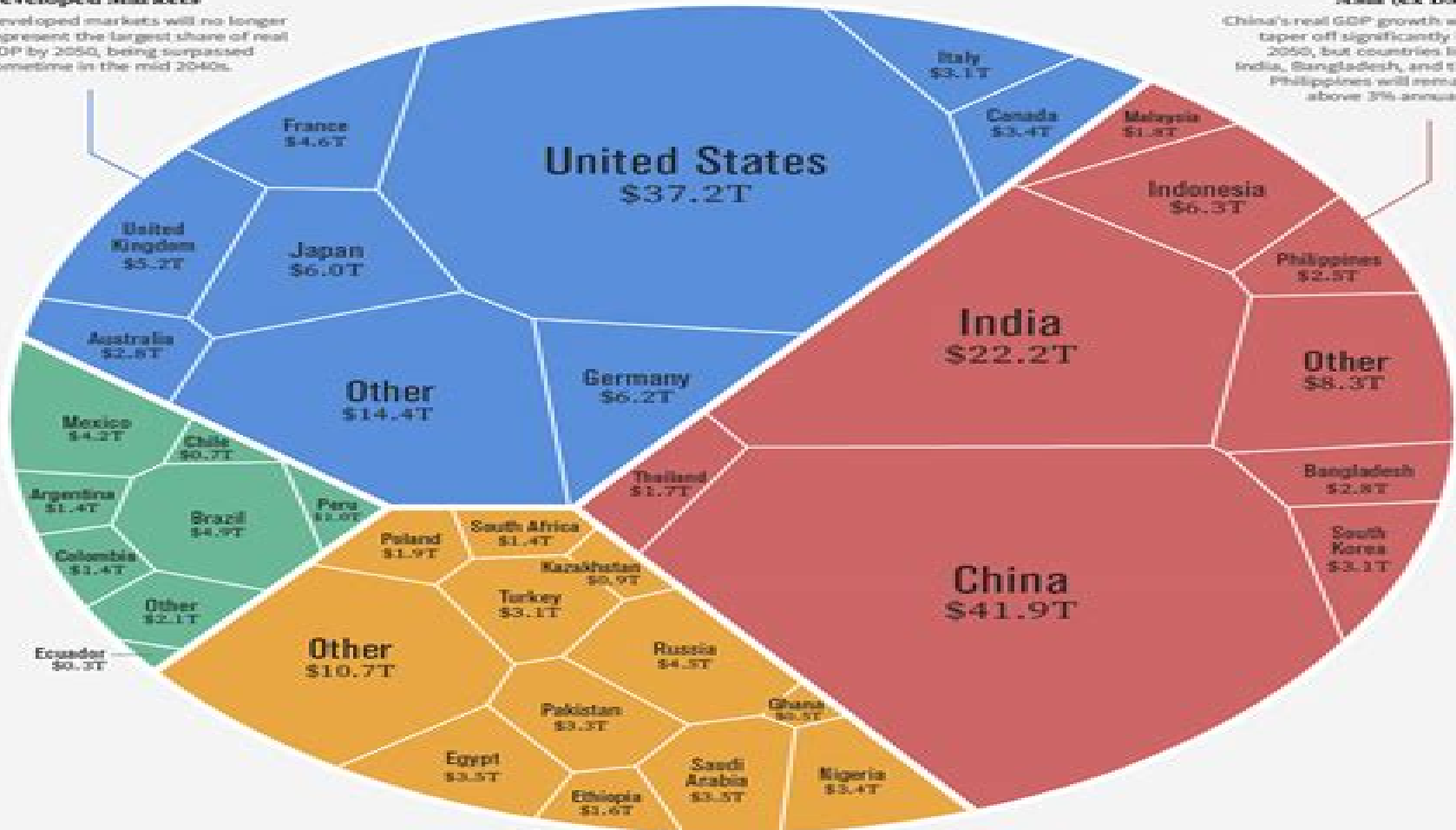


Developed Markets
