Williams points out that alteration of generations in conifers shows strong divergence in the evolution of male and female gametes as well as in the synchronicity of male and female gamete development. How are these coordinated to achieve fertilization? Books on conifer reproduction are all too rare. The only major work in the last generation was Hardev Singh's 1978 *Embryology of Gymnosperms*, a book that summarized the previous century's work. Being a book primarily about embryology, it stopped short of putting conifer reproduction in a genetic or evolutionary context.
