First Air Campaign Harry O Lawson,1996-03-21 The skies over Europe during World War I saw a uniquely modern contest for tactical and technological supremacy Each new strategy or invention by the Allies or Central Powers quickly brought a deadly response from the other Each innovation was tested in the air by combat pilots who were gambling with their lives At times with a life expectancy of only 21 flying days the pilots became the most enduring legend of the War Eric and Jane Lawson present a unique treatment of the air actions of World War I as a single grand campaign with the balance of power shifting back and forth with each new weapon or tactic World War I broke out in August 1914 only 11 years after the Wright brothers first airplane flight The warring nations assembled makeshift air forces of civilian aircraft flown by amateur pilots largely for reconnaissance purposes By the end of 1915 haphazard observation hand dropped bombs and pilots occasionally shooting at each other with carbines and begun to give way to specialized air squadrons specially designed aircraft bomb racks aerial cameras and mounted machine guns By war s end long range bombing rudimentary aircraft carriers rocket and cannon armed planes radios ground attach tactics and other features of modern warfare had made an appearance Eric and Jane Lawson maintain focus on the human dimension of the conflict The most important commanders and pilots are examined as well as groundbreaking coverage of the first African American combat pilot the first women to fly military missions and Fiorello LaGuardia s days as an Italian bombardier Billy Mitchell s image as an advocate of air power is balanced with a detailed account of his role in the St Mihiel offensive in which he assembled the war s largest air armada made up of American British French and even Italian aircraft The First Air Campaign features a fast paced narrative supplemented by detailed information on unit organization and aircraft performance and innovated new maps illustrating the first attempts to apply the principles of war to aerial maneuver Also included are unique war time photographs some not seen in 75 years and specially prepared charts available nowhere else graphically portraying the ever changing balance of air power throughout the war

Battlefronts had become immobilized in the grip of machine guns and heavy artillery, leading to slaughter on an unprecedented scale. The end of the war saw exhausted governments extricating themselves from the carnage, but some leaders were concerned that sooner or later another major war would follow. As France's Marshal Foch put it, the Treaty of Versailles was only a twenty-year truce. The overriding concern was to find ways in the future of avoiding the kind of static battlefronts that had consumed so many in such futile efforts. Military aviation was seen as the one great innovation that had the potential to do this by revolutionizing warfare. Billy Mitchell's War with the Navy Thomas Wildenberg,2014-02-15 In the years following WWI the U S Congress was more interested in disarmament than in funding

national defense For the military services this meant lean budgets and skeleton operating forces Billy Mitchell's War recounts the struggle between the Army and Navy air arms for the resources needed to define and establish the role of aviation within their respective services in the period between the two world wars When Billy Mitchell returned from WW I he brought with him the deep seated belief that air power had made armies and navies obsolete When Congress rejected the concept of a unified air service in 1920 Mitchell and his supporters turned on the Navy seeking to substitute the Air Service as the nation's first line of defense While Mitchell proved that aircraft could sink a battleship with the bombing of the Ostfriesland in 1921 he was unable to convince the General Staff of the Army the General Board of the Navy the Secretary of War the Secretary of the Navy or Congress of the need for an independent air force When Mitchell turned to the pen to discredit the Navy he was convicted by his own words and actions in a court martial that captivated the nation and was forced to resign in 1925 Rather than ending the rivalry for air power Mitchell's resignation set the stage for the ongoing dispute between the two services in the years immediately before WWII
