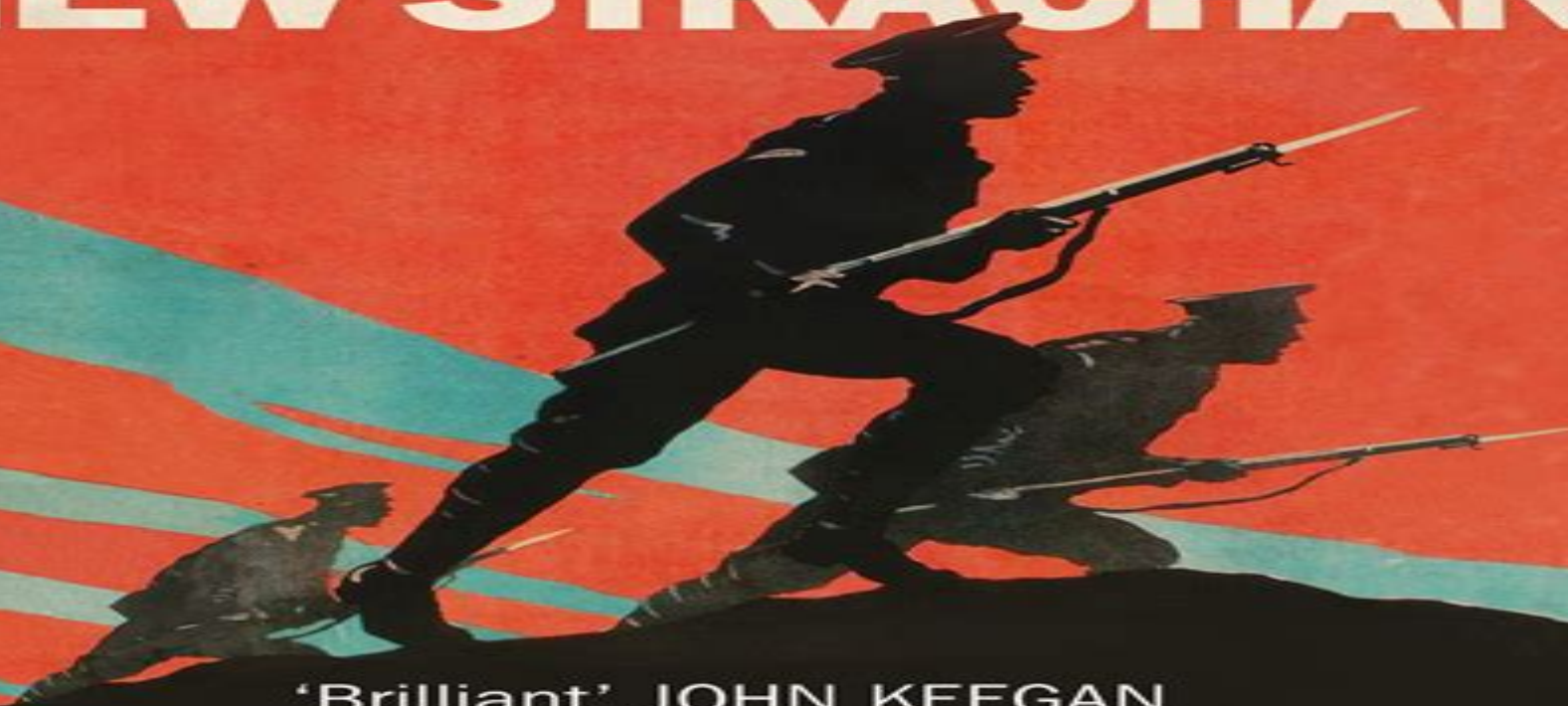

## **First World War In Fiction:**
