- The relationship between the national and state governments changes with time and political trends
 - Under dual federalism, up to the Civil War, states were dominant
 - Under cooperative federalism, beginning with the Great Depression, the federal government supplied more money to state and local governments to provide for their citizens
 - Beginning with creative federalism in the 1960s, greater authority has been gradually returned to the states
 - The strings attached to federal grants have come to be called coercive federalism
