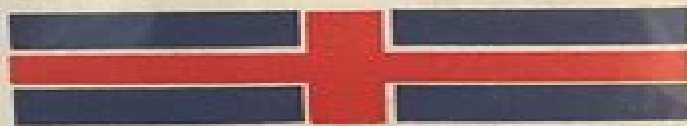

Thomas Jefferson Wertenbaker, 1948 Philip Freneau Jacob Axelrad, 2014-01-13 Philip Freneau was a poet editor and mariner A graduate of Princeton he was the roommate of James Madison and a classmate of Hugh Henry Brackenridge and Aaron Burr When the colonies rebelled against England he supported his newly born nation as a privateer spending some time in a British prison as a result He also served more effectively as the poet of the Revolution Later he became the journalistic voice of the democrats Ardently devoted to liberty he believed himself to be a defender of the common man for whom he fought selflessly and often vitriolically throughout his life In newspapers such as The Freeman's Journal The New York Daily Advertiser The National Gazette The Jersey Chronicle and The Time Piece he published articles letters and poems instructing the citizens of the new Republic about their rights and attacking those who he believed were infringing on those rights In the midst of the controversy in which he was so often involved he also found time to write a small body of poetry whose sensitivity and beauty mark him as the poetic equal of his European contemporaries and in fact as a precursor of the new Romantic movement In Philip Freneau Champion of Democracy Jacob Axelrad provides a detailed biography of this pensman of the Revolution and early Republic He gives a sympathetic imaginative perceptive yet objective interpretation of Freneau and his place in history and at the same time he presents a delightfully readable and clear picture of the period during which the poet lived These pages not only re create the battles between Whig and Tory federalist and democrat but they also are alive with the activities and philosophies of the men who made American history James Madison Thomas Jefferson Alexander Hamilton George Washington John Adams James Monroe go about the business of creating and shaping a new country and as they do they move into and out of the life of the poet of Monmouth influencing him in a variety of ways Above all Axelrad brings to life for the reader the man Freneau simple direct often uncritical in his devotion to the cause he believed in courageous in sustaining his stand against strong opposition disillusioned and pessimistic about human nature yet boldly optimistic about the future of humanity and of his country And always behind the furor the reader is aware of the man struggling to provide a living for himself and his family and never quite succeeding **Loyalist Rebellion in New Brunswick** David Bell, 2013-09-18 The American refugees who fled north to Canada after Britain's defeat by the revolutionary U S army were determined to build a culture separate from the U S By their numbers and their politics they became effectively the founders of English Canada In 1784 Britain carved out the new province New Brunswick for these Loyalist refugees creating a special homeland where they could run their own show But given a chance to found a new society the Loyalist refugees turned against each other in a savage contest for political power In Saint John where 10 000 people arrived in a space of months an elite of well connected powerful men mainly from Massachusetts allied themselves

with officials appointed by Britain and sought to control the levers of power in the colony They were opposed by upstart political leaders who with the support of a majority of residents bitterly fought the already entrenched minority The result was conflict a war of words that soon escalated into mob violence and criminal trials British soldiers were called out in defiance of normal constitutional practice to restore order When the critics of the governor won an election the governor and his coterie engineered a reversal of the result Popular political leaders were charged and convicted of sedition Then the governor and his supporters passed legislation making even written petitions illegal The new colony s conservative elite used every available device to maintain their grip on power In the end the governor boasted to London that the new colony was now passive and obedient The hostility of colonial administrators in Canada to dissent and political opposition and their labelling their opponents even Loyalists as disloyal rebels was long lasting From his extensive research in early records and his understanding of this crucial period David G Bell has written a fascinating account of early Canadian politics that challenges many conventional ideas about the role of Loyalists and British colonial administrators in Canada s original political culture
