A father shouldn't have to fight strangers in court for the right to parent his own child.

The adoption "industry" has become expert at circumventing a father's right to parent his child. Common methods include: *failing to secure a relinquishment or legal termination of parental rights *taking the expectant mother out of state to conceal the child and/or avoid putative fathers' registries "publishing "due diligence notices" in obscure publications *taking advantage of military deployment or assignment "listing the father as "unknown" Educate yourself.
