The next limitation is that a large number of articles appearing in various decades also cover individual aspects of Faulkner's themes and characters and give only partial treatment to his women characters. The fourth limitation is that even while discussing Faulkner as moralist the concentration is more on the male figure than the female figures The last limitation of Faulkner scholarship is that mostly it concentrates on his craftsmanship a large number of studies on Faulkner assess his stylistics and technique Tracing technical aspects thematic patterns and stylistic devices used by him critics establish Faulkner scholarship but are oblivion to the central thrust of women characters Thus Faulkner scholarship treats women characters either as secondary characters or at the most in relation to their male counterparts only They have been treated less as individuals than as common commodities the critics have been casual in their approach
