

PREFACE.

A few years ago, perhaps longer than I wish to remember, I asked Professor Joseph L. Blumenthal, who was then writing his biography of William Faulkner, what directions he thought Faulkner studies would take. Expecting an answer related to biography, I was surprised when Professor Blumenthal said that, at least for the foreseeable future, he thought the important work in Faulkner criticism would center on Faulkner's manuscripts and typewrites. From conversations I have had with other Faulkner critics, it is quite clear that Professor Blumenthal is not alone in his views. Yet, it took a while for me to realize gradually the import of Professor Blumenthal's comments; anyone who spends weeks and months reading Faulkner's manuscripts and typewrites cannot help but experience the thrill and satisfaction of appreciating even more the genius of Faulkner's creative imagination. My own experience in this has given me a respect for the Faulknerian world, not only in its sweeping historical, social, and literary dimensions, but in the specificity of individual words and phrases.

In the last few years, Faulkner criticism has grown tremendously, as expected, and it is excellent and some a bit repetitious. Few have the time, energy, and resources to keep up with all that is being published on Faulkner in this country and abroad. I make no pretensions in this regard. Yet, I am convinced that if criticism on Faulkner's works is not based in some ultimate way on a knowledge of his books as he wrote them, that is on both the text and content of his works, then criticism will deal with a Yoknapatawpha County even more complicated than even Faulkner would have wished. As rigorous scholars know as well, the dissemination of criticism about theological texts must be based on a reverence for all the dimensions of the text. Many scholars have often mentioned that until we have adequate editions of Faulkner's works, and at least one series of texts that are fully annotated, then we will have to deal with a

Towner, 2010-12-01 This study argues that Faulkner's writings about racial matters interrogated rather than validated his racial beliefs and that in the process of questioning his own ideology, his fictional forms extended his reach as an artist. After winning the Nobel Prize in 1950, Faulkner wrote what critics term his later novels. These have been almost uniformly dismissed with the prevailing view being that as he became a more public figure, his fiction became a platform rather than a canvas. Within this context, *Faulkner on the Color Line* redeems the novels in the final phase of his career by interpreting them as Faulkner's way of addressing the problem of race in America. They are seen as a series of formal experiments Faulkner deliberately attempted as he examined the various cultural functions of narrative, most particularly those narratives that enforce American racial ideology. The first chapters look at the ways in which the ability to assert oneself verbally informs matters of individual and cultural identity in both the widely studied works of Faulkner's major phase and those in his later career. Later chapters focus on the last works, providing detailed readings of *Intruder in the Dust*, *Requiem for a Nun*, the *Snopes* trilogy, *A Fable*, and *The Reivers*. The book examines Faulkner as he confronted the vexing questions of race in these novels and assesses the identity of Faulkner as the Nobel Prize winner who claimed on many occasions that he was tired, maybe written out. In his decision not to speak in the identity of the Black people represented in his fiction, in his decision to write instead about the complexities of all racial constructions, he produced a host of characters suffering within the rigid protocols on race that had been enforced in America for centuries. As a private white individual, he could never be other than what he was. Rather than attempt to reconcile Faulkner the public man with the private one, however, this study concludes that through his fiction, Faulkner the artist questioned himself and came to understand others across the color line.

Forensic Fictions Jay Watson, 2008-11-01 *Forensic Fictions* is the first book-length critical study of William Faulkner's fictional depictions of the legal vocation and the practice of law. Examining Faulkner's lawyer characters in light of the southern storytelling tradition, Jay Watson argues that the forensic competence of the Faulknerian lawyer is a direct function of his skill as a raconteur. To trace the biographical and historical roots of Faulkner's lifelong preoccupation with the legal profession, Watson draws on contemporary scholarship in narrative rhetoric, jurisprudence, legal and intellectual history, literary theory, and Lacanian psychoanalysis. His approach yields insightful readings of forensic characters and scenes from such works as *An Odor of Verbena*, *The Hamlet*, *Wild Palms*, *Absalom, Absalom!*, and *The Reivers*. examining the intertextual logic that connects the two most important lawyers in the Yoknapatawpha fiction the incompetent Horace Benbow and the more capable Gavin Stevens whose entrance into Faulkner's oeuvre coincides with Benbow's untimely departure from it Focusing on the nine novels in which these two characters appear Watson traces the evolutionary process by which Stevens supplants Benbow Three of the Stevens novels *Intruder in the Dust* *Knight's Gambit* and *Requiem for a Nun* from what Watson calls Faulkner's forensic trilogy and when read together constitute the writer's most sustained investigation of the rhetorical and ethical responsibilities of the lawyer citizen Faulkner Watson argues saw the forensic figure as a potential hybrid of *homo loquens* and *homo politicus* capable of combining the roles of storyteller rhetorician and theatrical performer with those of critic citizen and ethical man As such this figure served as a provocative authorial surrogate through whom Faulkner could explore diverse and often contradictory aspects of his personal experience his family background his cultural heritage and most of all his own artistic use of language
