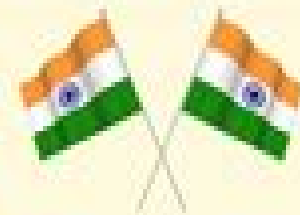

from divergent monetary policy from peers adjustments to monetary policy settings have commenced Given high public debt fiscal consolidation to rebuild fiscal buffers underpinned by a credible medium term fiscal framework to put the debt to GDP ratio on a clear downward path is key Longer term sustainability also requires reducing greenhouse gas emissions in line with government targets calling for green investment innovation and carbon pricing Reforms to improve the innovation framework and incentives for start ups are key to boost productivity and address ageing pressures Removing obstacles to the employment of women and older persons and making greater use of foreign workers are also essential to counter demographic headwinds Strengthening the financial position of young people and policies to support families and children such as improved parental leave would help to reverse the downward trend in the fertility rate

Economic Growth in Oil-Exporting Countries Amir Sadeghi,2017-12-22 This paper examines the impact of government size on how output and government expenditure respond to oil price shocks in 28 oil exporting countries between 1990 and 2016 Results suggest that if the size of government measured by government expenditure to non oil GDP ratio is larger non oil output growth in response to a positive oil price shock tends to be greater and output volatility higher Furthermore I find that an unexpected increase in oil price leads to expansion in government expenditure and the expansion is larger the larger is the government This paper provides empirical evidence for direct correlation between government size and macroeconomic stability in oil exporting countries The findings imply that fiscal consolidation and economic diversification help to narrow down economic exposure to exogenous oil price shocks and reduce volatility in non oil output **International**
