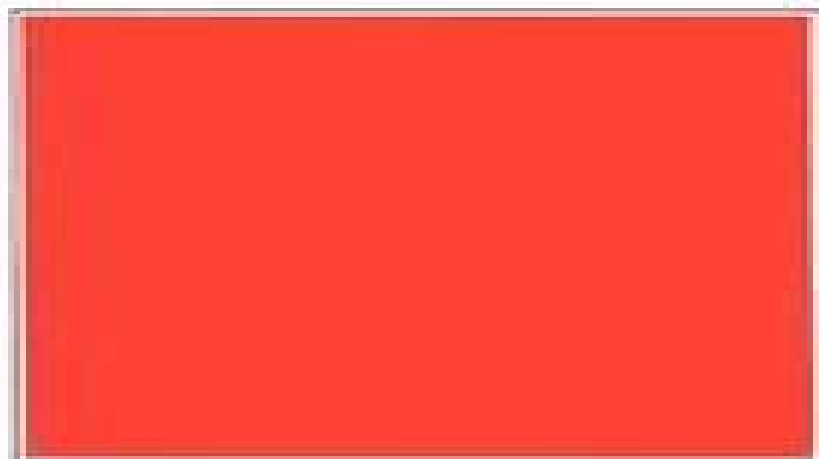

Antitrust and the Triumph of Economics Marc Allen Eisner, 2017-11-01 Some of the chief aims of President Ronald Reagan's economic agenda were to reduce the regulatory burden minimize state intervention and reinvigorate market mechanisms Toward these ends his administration limited antitrust enforcement to technical cases of price fixing invoking the doctrine of the Chicago school of economics In *Antitrust and the Triumph of Economics* Marc Eisner shows that the so called Reagan revolution was but an extension of well established trends He examines organizational and procedural changes in the Antitrust Division of the Department of Justice and the Federal Trade Commission that predated the 1980 election and forced the subsequent redefinition of policy During their early years the Antitrust Division and the FTC gave little attention to economic analysis In the period following World War II however economic analysis assumed an increasingly important role in both agencies and economists rose in status from being members of support staff to being pivotal decision makers who in effect shaped the policies for which elected officials were generally assumed to be responsible In the 1960s and 1970s critical shifts in prevailing economic theory within the academic community were transmitted into the agencies This had a profound effect on how antitrust was conceptualized in the federal government Thus when Ronald Reagan became president in 1981 the antitrust agencies were already pursuing a conservative enforcement program Eisner's study challenges dominant explanations of policy change through a focus on institutional evolution It has important implications for current
