Social Self-Organization Dirk Helbing, 2012-05-05 What are the principles that keep our society together This question is even more difficult to answer than the long standing question what are the forces that keep our world together However the social challenges of humanity in the 21st century ranging from the financial crises to the impacts of globalization require us to make fast progress in our understanding of how society works and how our future can be managed in a resilient and sustainable way This book can present only a few very first steps towards this ambitious goal However based on simple models of social interactions one can already gain some surprising insights into the social macro level outcomes and dynamics that is implied by individual micro level interactions Depending on the nature of these interactions they may imply the spontaneous formation of social conventions or the birth of social cooperation but also their sudden breakdown This can
