He thought these measures would encourage domestic production and so promote long term benefits. Malthus became hugely influential and controversial in economic, political, social and scientific thought. Many of those whom subsequent centuries term evolutionary biologists read him notably Charles Darwin and Alfred Russel Wallace for each of whom Malthusianism became an intellectual stepping stone to the idea of natural selection.
