Unfortunately writes Knapp size obsessed fashion magazines and other social messages contradict a woman's right to desire contributing to the rise in eating disorders and other illnesses Knapp observes an aspect of the backlash against the feminist movement when women were demanding the right to take up more space in the world they were being told by a still patriarchal society to grow physically smaller Though Knapp admits it's easier to worry about the body than the soul she hopes creating a dialogue about anorexia will enable all women to nourish both
