Fatima De Los Naufragios:

The Return of the Moor Daniela Flesler, 2008 With the intense economic development and accelerated modernization experienced by Spain since the 1970s and especially following its entrance to the European Economic Community in 1986 the country has undergone a rapid inversion in migratory patterns After being an exporter of economic migrants for almost a century in the last 20 years Spain has seen itself on the receiving end of immigration Coinciding with a time when Spain is highlighting its belonging to Europe the growing presence of Moroccan immigrants in particular confronts Spanish society with the repressed non European African and Oriental aspects of its national identity The Return of the Moor examines the anxiety over symbolic and literal boundaries permeating the Spanish reception of these immigrants through an interdisciplinary analysis of social fictional and performative texts It argues that Moroccans constitute a problem to Spaniards not because of their cultural differences as many claim but because they are not different enough Perceived as Moors they conjure up past ghosts that continue to haunt the Spanish imaginary revealing the acute tensions inherent to Spain's tenuous position between Europe and Africa

Ex-Centric Migrations Hakim Abderrezak, 2016-06-20 Plunges the reader into a tour de force across radically divergent artistic responses to Mediterranean migration *Bulletin of Francophone Postcolonial Studies* *Ex-Centric Migrations* examines cinematic literary and musical representations of migrants and migratory trends in the western Mediterranean Focusing primarily on clandestine sea crossings Hakim Abderrezak shows that despite labor and linguistic ties with the colonizer migrants from the Maghreb Morocco Algeria and Tunisia no longer systematically target France as a destination but instead aspire toward other European countries notably Spain and Italy In addition the author investigates other migratory patterns that entail the repatriation of migrants His analysis reveals that the films novels and songs of Mediterranean artists run contrary to mass media coverage and conservative political discourse bringing a nuanced vision and expert analysis to the sensationalism and biased reportage of such events as the Mediterranean maritime tragedies *Ex-Centric Migrations* is crucial reading for scholars and students of contemporary Maghrebi French and Spanish literatures and cultures It breaks new ground by encompassing the literature film and music of return migration and examining the trajectories of Maghrebi migration outside France

The Aesthetics of the Ephemeral Jennifer Duprey, 2014-07-01 In *The Aesthetics of the Ephemeral* Jennifer Duprey examines five contemporary plays from Barcelona *Olors* and *Testament* by Josep

Maria Benet i Jornet Ant gona by Jordi Coca Forasters by Sergi Belbel and Temptaci by Carles Batlle She argues that in both the theatrical text and its performance an aesthetics of the ephemeral materializes that is related to specific manifestations of cultural and historical memory in Spain and Catalonia These manifestations of memory include historical concerns such as the possibility of another form of justice in predicaments of violence after the Civil War and they also include contemporary issues such as the production of ruins by the processes of gentrification in Barcelona the complexity of immigration in Spain and the destruction or preservation of Catalan cultural legacies In her analysis of these topics Duprey engages and expands on theories related to questions of subjectivity and identity in late modernity This book will be of interest to those concerned with Iberian cultural studies and with how theater reflects on and contributes to contemporary political dialogue

Drawing on gender and queer studies, *Resisting Invisibility* investigates the gendering of crime fiction, forcing us to reconsider the literary history of female visibility and prompting us to establish an alternative genealogy for Spanish crime literature.
