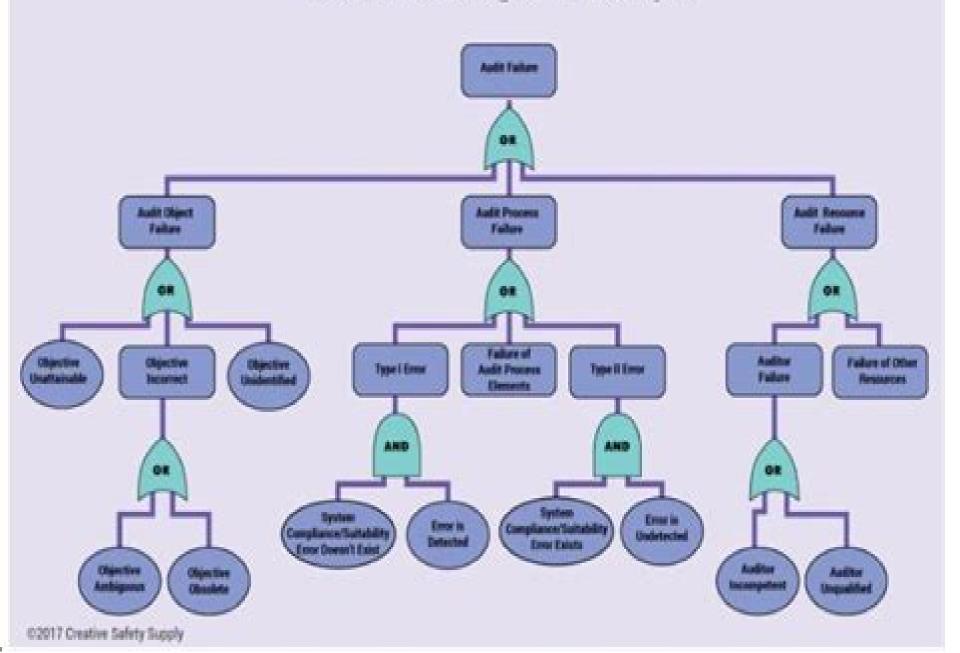
Fault Tree Diagram Example
