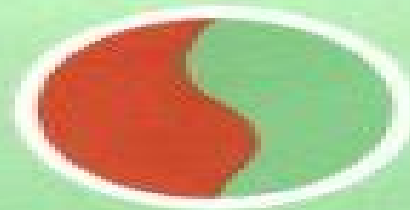

W. Lau, 2011 This study demonstrates the importance of including narrative ethics in a construction of Old Testament ethics as a correction for the current state of marginalisation of narrative in this discipline. To this end the concept of identity is used as a lens through which to understand and derive ethics. Since self-conception in ancient Israel is generally held to be predominantly collectivist in orientation social identity theory is used to understand ancient Israelite identity. Although collectivist sensitivities are important a social identity approach also incorporates an understanding of individuality. This approach highlights the social emphases of a biblical text and consequently assists in understanding a text's original ethical message. The book of Ruth is used as a test case employing a social identity approach for understanding the narrative but also to model the approach so that it can be implemented more widely in study of the Old Testament and narrative ethics.
