Many objects were designed to be multifunctional: pool and patio furniture that was equally suitable indoors; lighting that was both task and ambient; bookshelves that served as room dividers; and bathing suits that would turn into ensembles appropriate for indoor entertainment. California Design includes 350 images, most in color, of furniture, ceramics, metalwork, architecture, graphic and industrial design, film, textiles and fashion, and ten incisive essays that trace the rise of the California design aesthetic.
