Chatto and Windus before becoming a full time poet Her second volume of poetry *A Way of Looking* 1955 won the Somerset Maugham Award which allowed her to travel to Rome a city which had an immense impact on her poetry and Roman Catholic faith While she suffered from physical and mental ill health from her early thirties Jennings was a popular and widely read poet She received the W H Smith award in 1987 for *Collected Poems* 1953 1985 and in 1992 was awarded a CBE She died in Rosebank Care Home Bampton in 2001 and is buried in Wolvercote Cemetery Oxford
