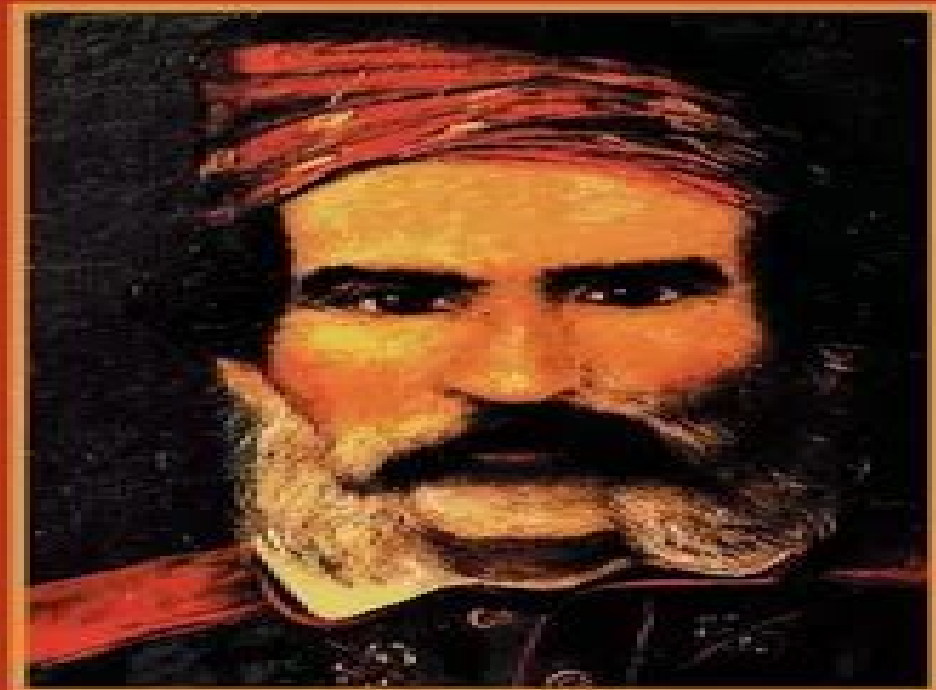

El Chacho Domingo Faustino Sarmiento, 2010-08-31 Sarmiento comienza a escribir *El Chacho* mientras reside en Estados Unidos como representante del gobierno argentino y lo hace con el propósito de incluirlo en el mismo volumen de la 3a edición del *Facundo* que aparecer en Nueva York durante el último tramo de su campaña presidencial. Este es un texto provocativo y desafiante y cabe preguntarse qué le llevó a Sarmiento publicar en 1868 la historia de Vicente Pealoza, un general de la Nación asesinado cinco años antes, vencido, prisionero y desarmado, mientras el coronel Sarmiento combatía a la montonera desde el gobierno de San Juan. Vicente Pealoza más conocido como el Chacho, Pealoza se rindió al comandante Ricardo Vera en Loma Blanca, paraje aledaño al pueblo de Olta, entregándole su propia última arma que le quedaba. Una hora más tarde llegó Irrazabal y de forma vengativa lo asesinó con su lanza y a continuación hizo que sus soldados lo acribillaran a balazos. Al Chacho le cortaron la cabeza y la clavaron en la punta de un poste en la plaza de Olta en presencia de su familia. Una de sus orejas presidió por mucho las reuniones de la clase civilizada de San Juan. A Victoria Romero, su esposa, la obligaron a barrer la plaza mayor de la ciudad de San Juan atada con cadenas. Al conocer la noticia, Sarmiento escribió al presidente Mitre: «No sé qué pensar ni de la ejecución del Chacho, yo inspirado en los hombres pacíficos y honrados he aplaudido la medida precisamente por su forma sin cortarle la cabeza al inveterado por lo que las chusmas no se habrán aquietado en seis meses». **El Chacho**, 2014 **Gauchos and the Vanishing Frontier** Richard W.

Dabové, 2007-06-17 *Nightmares of the Lettered City* presents an original study of the popular theme of banditry in works of literature, essays, poetry, and drama, and banditry's pivotal role during the conceptualization and formation of the Latin American nation-state. Juan Pablo Dabové examines writings over a broad time period from the early nineteenth century to the 1920s, and while *Nightmares of the Lettered City* focuses on four crucial countries—Argentina, Mexico, Brazil, and Venezuela—it is the first book to address the depiction of banditry in Latin America as a whole. The work offers close reading of *Facundo*, *Doña Barbara*, *Os Sertões*, and *Martin Fierro*, among other works, illuminating the ever-changing and often contradictory political agendas of the literary elite in their portrayals of the forms of peasant insurgency labeled banditry. Banditry has haunted the Latin American literary imagination. As a cultural trope, banditry has always been an uneasy compromise between desire and anxiety, a nightmare. Dabové isolates three main representational strategies. He analyzes the bandit as radical other, a figure through which the elites depicted the threats posed to them by various sectors outside the lettered city. Further, he considers the bandit as a trope used in elite internecine struggles. In this case, rural insurgency was a

means to legitimize or refute an opposing sector or faction within the lettered city Finally Dabove shows how in certain cases the bandit was used as an image of the nonstate violence that the nation state has to suppress as a historical force and simultaneously exalt as a memory in order to achieve cultural coherence and actual sovereignty As Dabove convincingly demonstrates the elite s construction of the bandit is essential to our understanding of the development of the Latin American nation in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries

Facundo Domingo F. Recollections of a Provincial Past Domingo Faustino Sarmiento, 2005 Domingo Faustino Sarmiento 1811-1888 was Argentina s leading writer educator and politician of the nineteenth century and served as President from 1868 to 1874 Of his several autobiographies the best known *Recollections of a Provincial Past* is one of the indisputable classics of Spanish American literature as well as one of the earliest autobiographies written in the Americas in

Spanish Written in exile in 1850 the memoirs describe his childhood and adolescence in an Andean province whose customs were still those of a colony Sarmiento presents his life as the triumph of civilization over barbarism looking back on his youth he measures his wealth and strength by the accumulation of enriching personal and political experiences He compares himself to the newly independent Argentina claiming to be a historically representative individual whose trajectory serves to illuminate contemporary South America Sarmiento and His Argentina Joseph Criscenti, Joseph T. Criscenti, 1993 Domingo Faustino Sarmiento president of Argentina from 1868 to 1874 is best known as an educator and as the author of *Civilization and Barbarism* The Life of Juan Facundo Quiroga generally referred to as El Facundo The contributors to this volume call attention to other facets of Sarmiento's life and to the results of the programs he encouraged *El Chacho* Domingo F.
