Your therapist will simultaneously have you do specific eye movements. The billoteral etimulation may also include tops or other movements mixed in, depending on your case.

After the bilateral stimulation, your therapist will ask you to let your mind go blank and notice the thoughts and teetings you're having spantaneously. After you blentilly these thoughts, your therapist may have you refocus on that traumatic memory, or move on to according

If you become distressed, your therapist will help bring you back to the present below moving on to another troumatic memory. Over time, the distress over particular thoughts, images, or memories should start to lade.

STAGE 6

BODY SCAN

This stage checks the client's body for any physical response to the targeted memory and is used to adjust the tody responses.

STAGE 7

CLOSURE

This is the stope in between reprocessing, here the client is called to be owne of the disturbances that might arise in between sensions and make notes in order to address the issues in fullure sessions.

STAGE 8

RE-EVALUATION AND REITERATION FOR FUTURE TREATMENT

in the final phose, the client and the theropist, individually and jointly, evolute progress ofter these sessions to check for optimal treatment effects.
