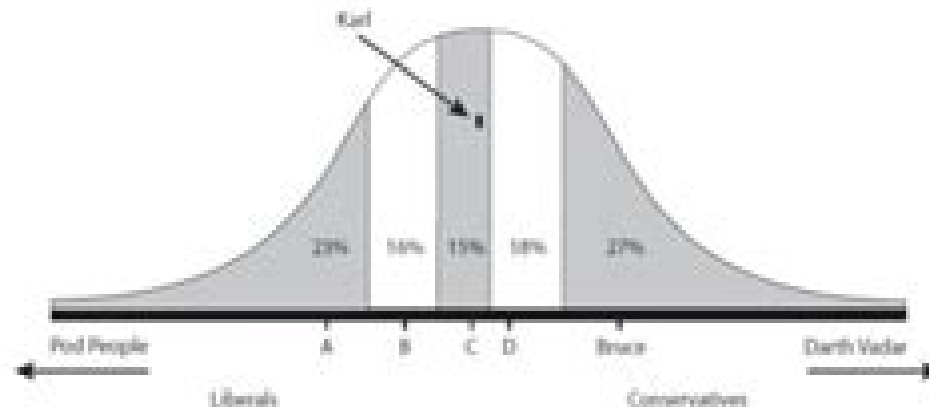


An Economic Theory of Democracy


