The Dismantling of the Good Neighbor Policy Bryce Wood, 2010-07-22 The Good Neighbor Policy was unique a great power obligated itself not to use force in its dealings with twenty smaller powers and not to interfere in their domestic politics It was a policy that lasted with some perturbations for twenty years instituted by President Roosevelt in 1933 and carried out effectively from 1933 to 1943 by word and action maintained during the Second World War largely as a result of British concern for continuance of Argentine beef exports codified in the Charter of the Organization of American States in 1948 and reasserted by Truman and Acheson in 1950 51 it was covertly repudiated in Guatemala in 1954 by Eisenhower and the Dulles brothers and not so secretly by Kennedy in the disastrous Bay of Pigs
