Bannockburns Robert Crawford,2014-01-14 Poet and critic Robert Crawford explores in eloquent detail the literary cultural background to Scottish nationalism in the lead up to the referendum on independence for Scotland from the United Kingdom in September 2014 He begins with the totemic Battle of Bannockburn in 1314 in which the Scots routed the English and preserved their independence until the two nations parliaments united in 1707 Paying particular attention to Robert Burns and continuing up to the present day he examines how writers have set out in poetry fiction plays and on film the ideal of Scottish independence Publication coincides with the 700 year anniversary of the Battle of Bannockburn

'Keeping the Sources Pure' Sabine Schmid,2003 This volume assesses the literary stature of George Mackay Brown by contextualising his prose and his poetry within twentieth century British and European literary practices and traditions of thought Challenging the typecasting of Brown as Orkney writer the book links him with European Modernism and reveals the complex web of experiences influences and relationships that shaped Brown s poetic development This comparative study argues that Edwin Muir Gerard Manley Hopkins and Thomas Mann analysed remarkably similar cultural and spiritual phenomena inspiring Brown s own work Muir travelled back into what he called the racial memory of the tribe Hopkins aimed for a revival of religious values and the recovery of the sacramental power of the word Thomas Mann felt that man must discover and put into practice a new humanism which would embrace the mythic archetypal structure of the unconscious and man s individual consciousness All four writers attempted to get back to the

roots and sources by probing the ways in which individuals and society as a whole gain a better understanding of and a more meaningful relationship with their pasts This book chronicles George Mackay Brown's personal and artistic journey from his early reporting days on an Orkney newspaper through spells in hospital recovering from tuberculosis to his friendship with Edwin Muir and growing confidence in his own vision

A Life Composed André Schüller, 2002 The modern literary critic T S Eliot wrote in 1929 must be an experimenter outside of what you might at first consider his own province there is no literary problem which does not lead us irresistibly to larger problems This book follows Eliot's principle and situates his literary and critical work in a wide context that reveals manifold links between aesthetics ethics politics and epistemology the historical context of early twentieth century idealism vitalism and pragmatism especially the intensely political Bergsonian controversy and the modern context of the philosophies of Charles Taylor Michel Foucault and Richard Rorty Knowledge it argues was verbalised in the modernist age individualised into the act of knowing an act with motives and goals and thus introduced into the realm of ethics a process central to twentieth century thought Eliot's poems especially constructed as a life composed a literary lifetime linking composition and composure ponder the virtue of precision the sins of pride and mental sloth the temptation of prejudice and the need for conviction Decidedly tentative Eliot's poems solve the problem of morally significant literature In a century of suspicion they ask the crucial question of where one should start to rely

Minority Language Writers in the Wake of World War One Jelle Krol, 2020-08-20 This book presents a comparative literary study of the works of four writers working in European minority languages Frisian Welsh Scots and Breton The author examines the different strategies employed by the four writers to create distinctive literary fields for their languages in the interwar era when self-determination had been promised to national minorities finding that each had to make some degree of a step backwards into the past to enable them to make a leap forward The book also discusses the problems resulting from this oscillation between traditionalism and modernism drawing on concepts such as Pascale Casanova's littératures combattives to make sense of these minority languages and communities within the wider European context This study will be of interest to students and scholars of minority languages particularly the four explored here as well as twentieth century and comparative literature multilingualism and language policy
