- Blames the international system for the backwardness of underdeveloped countries.
- Indigenous economic development was subverted first through political imperialism and now through what might be called economic imperialism.
  - First, the Europeans subjected the Third World to their colonial domination and now, after independence,
  - Third World countries are trapped in a cycle of economic dependency.
    - Free trade, foreign investments, foreign aid, and MNCs work to the disadvantage of the Third World.
    - They keep the Third World in a permanent condition of economic neo-colonialism.
