Los niños/as y adolescentes no solo constituyen un grupo clínico particular con necesidades propias, con expresiones de sus trastornos enormemente heterogéneos y diferentes a los adultos, sino que revisten una condición de vulnerabilidad que vuelve imprescindible todos nuestros intentos. Sus familias también requieren atención, orientación, respuestas tentativas que son responsabilidad al menos en parte de los profesionales que nos especializamos en este campo. A partir de allí es que decidí profundizar mis investigaciones y sistematizarlas, resultando de ese proceso el desarrollo de mi tesis doctoral realizada en el convenio USAL-APA. En ese proceso pude organizar mis interrogantes y buscar respuestas y describir procesos y resultados clínicos sin perder mi identidad y perspectiva como psicoanalista. Ese material es la base de este libro. He logrado separar sus puntos centrales en términos teóricos y hacerlos accesibles para expertos y también para aquellos que están explorando el tema por interés o necesidad personal. Decidí plantear dos ejes fundamentales: en el primero, el desarrollo del soporte conceptual para pensar las patologías severas en niños/as y adolescentes como trastornos del Yo, y avanzar entonces sobre sus modos de

constitución y sus fallas. Es decir cuáles son las consecuencias subjetivas cuando este Yo está desorganizado o inexistente en muchos casos. Debo resaltar que mi formación como psicoanalista es esencial para pensar los diagnósticos, las dimensiones donde localizo sus imposibilidades, los abordajes pertinentes y las formas de evaluarlos, cambios en los procesos terapéuticos.
