

White, 1989 A former singing cowboy himself John I White spent decades compiling information on cowboy and western songs and the artists songwriters and others attached to them He also sought out and corresponded with a who s who of the genre people like Badger Clark Curley Fletcher D J O Malley Romaine Lowdermilk Will Barnes Joseph Mills Hanson and Owen Wister In Git Along Little Dogies White draws on old friendships and his exhaustive files to bring readers the untold story of cowboy and western song Wonderful anecdotes stand beside White s trademark attention to detail as he painstakingly establishes the time place and circumstance behind each song s origin and places the music within the evolution of popular song He also looks at how radio and recording affected the genre and shows how the music crisscrossed with pop music but also with folk and the traditional Anglo Irish tradition From Whoopee Ti Yi Yo to Ten Thousand Cattle Straying Git Along Little Dogies ventures from cow camps to saloons to big city radio studios as it lassos a vivid piece of American music history Git along, little dogies John I. White, 1975 **Behind the Burnt Cork Mask** William John Mahar, 1999 The songs dances jokes parodies spoofs and skits of blackface groups such as the Virginia Minstrels and Buckley's Serenaders became wildly popular in antebellum America Behind the Burnt Cork Mask not only explores the racist practices of these entertainers but considers their performances as troubled representations of ethnicity class gender and culture in the nineteenth century William J Mahar s unprecedented archival study of playbills newspapers sketches monologues and music engages new sources previously not considered in twentieth century scholarship More than any other study of its kind Behind the Burnt Cork Mask investigates the relationships between blackface comedy and other Western genres and traditions between the music of minstrel shows and its European sources and between popular and elite constructions of culture By locating minstrel performances within their complex sites of production Mahar offers a significant reassessment of the historiography of the field Behind the Burnt Cork Mask promises to redefine the study of blackface minstrelsy charting new directions for future inquiries by scholars in American studies popular culture and musicology

Lost Sounds Tim Brooks, Richard Keith Spottswood, 2004-02-24 Available in paperback for the first time this groundbreaking in depth history of the involvement of African Americans in the early recording industry examines the first three decades of sound recording in the United States charting the surprising roles black artists played in the period leading up to the Jazz Age and the remarkably wide range of black music and culture they preserved Applying more than thirty years of scholarship Tim Brooks identifies key black artists who recorded commercially and provides illuminating biographies for some forty of these audio pioneers Brooks assesses the careers and recordings of George W Johnson Bert Williams George Walker Noble Sissle Eubie Blake the Fisk Jubilee Singers W C Handy James Reese Europe Wilbur Sweatman Harry T Burleigh Roland Hayes Booker T Washington and boxing champion Jack Johnson as well as a host of lesser known voices
