

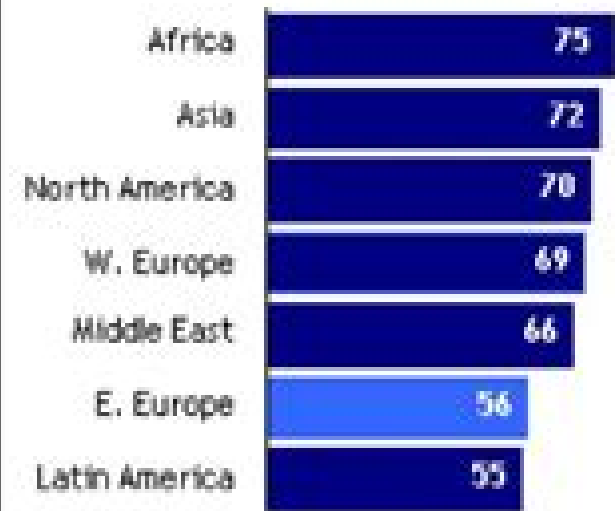

- Historically, Eastern Europe has been less well developed than Western Europe
 - Has been under control of outsiders (Ottoman Turks, Germans, Soviet Russians)
 - **Soviet Russians redeveloped Eastern Europe after WWII as communist, slowing down their goal towards development**

"A 47-nation 2007 Pew Global Attitudes survey found that, among the seven major world regions included in the study, support for free markets was lowest in Eastern Europe and Latin America.
