Kent Weaver, 2000 Bill Clinton's first presidential term was a period of extraordinary change in policy toward low income families In 1993 Congress enacted a major expansion of the Earned Income Tax Credit for low income working families In 1996 Congress passed and the president signed the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act This legislation abolished the sixty year old Aid to Families with Dependent Children AFDC program and replaced it with a block grant program Temporary Assistance for Needy
