recasting of history followed by Bruno Bauer's absolute atheism and Ludwig Feuerbach's statement that Man is God. This soon found reflection in the Sacred History of Mankind declared by Moses Hess. Within a decade the result was the secular reformulation of this theological ideology into the Scientific Socialism of Karl Marx and Frederick Engels. Although linked to it, Max Stirner was the most relentless and feared critic of this school. His work never out of print but largely ignored by academics has inspired countless individualists set upon rejecting any form of religious or political causes and finding Stirner's assertion that he had set his cause upon nothing took this as their own cause.
