indeterminacy is pushed to further extremes in Ulysses with its notorious proliferation of narrative perspectives As a corollary to the work s encyclopaedic inclusiveness and quotidian particularism every detail tends to assume the same significance as every other the consequence being that in Gyorgy Lukacs famous formulation we lose all sense of any hierarchy of meaning From that it is but a step to Franco Moretti s assessment that in Ulysses everyday existence remains inert opaque meaningless and that in fact the whole point is to represent the meaningless precisely as meaningless Indeterminacy in effect ushers in the possibility of nihilism The analysis of Ulysses culminates with the attempt unavailing in both cases to discover in either Bloom or Molly a genuine source of countervailing affirmation The study concludes with a brief consideration of the polysemic vocabulary of Finnegans Wake as a logical extrapolation of the poetics of indeterminacy
