The Architecture of Grosvenor Atterbury Peter Pennoyer, Anne Walker, 2009-07-28 The first close look at an innovative architect and inventor who held that traditional styles could be successfully adapted for modern times In the final decade of the nineteenth century and the early twentieth century the United States experienced exponential growth and a flourishing economy and with it a building boom Grosvenor Atterbury 1869 1956 produced more than one hundred major projects including an array of grand mansions picturesque estates informal summer cottages and farm groups However it was his role as town planner and civic leader and his work to create model tenements hospitals workers housing and town plans for which he is most celebrated His Forest Hills Gardens designed in association with the Olmsted Brothers is lauded as one of the most highly significant community planning projects of its time As an inventor Atterbury was responsible for one of the country's first low cost prefabricated concrete construction systems introducing beauty and inexpensive good design into the lives of the working classes The Architecture of Grosvenor Atterbury is the first book to showcase the rich and varied repertoire of this prolific architect whose career spanned six decades and whose work affected the course of American architecture planning and construction Illustrated with Jonathan Wallen's stunning color photographs and over 250 historic drawings plans and photographs it also includes a catalogue raisonné and an employee roster It is the definitive source on an architect who made an indelible imprint on the American landscape *Tucson Visitors' Guide* ,1922

La Calle Lydia R. Otero,2016-10-01 On March 1 1966 the voters of Tucson approved the Pueblo Center Redevelopment Project Arizona s first major urban renewal project which targeted the most densely populated eighty acres in the state For close to one hundred years tucsonenses had created their own spatial reality in the historical predominantly Mexican American heart of the city an area most called la calle Here amid small retail and service shops restaurants and entertainment venues they openly lived and celebrated their culture To make way for the Pueblo Center s new buildings city officials proceeded to displace la calle s residents and to demolish their ethnically diverse neighborhoods which contends Lydia Otero challenged the spatial and cultural assumptions of postwar modernity suburbia and urban planning Otero examines conflicting claims to
