Chapter 2 introduces you to the Cotswolds that are the trail's setting, in particular their geology, grasslands, and woodland, distinctive settlement pattern of small towns and villages, vernacular architecture, and historical monuments ranging from Neolithic barrows and Iron Age hill forts to Roman villas, medieval castles, manor houses, and wool churches, along with several notable towers and beacons. Chapters 3-12 deal with the typically ten-mile or so long stages of the annual Cotswold Way walks that Cotswold Voluntary Wardens lead.
