

This concerns both freedom rights which must not depend on the ability of humans to pay and the model of democracy and respect for the rule of law Thirdly insoluble problems of application arise for cost benefit analyses which are particularly but not only apparent in the context of climate protection in general considerations as in the case of legislation as well as in individual analyses as done when constructing a coal fired power plant A strongly deflated cost benefit analysis could nevertheless contribute

factual material such as partial aspects of decision consequences that can actually be depicted in monetary terms to ethical or legal decision making processes In this respect the approach appears helpful and complementary but not beyond that
