Ethnography research is a technique researchers use: to learn about people in a specific environment. More in-depth than observational research, ethnographic research actually requires that the researcher participate in the environment that they are observing.



WHEN SHOULD I DO ETHNOGRAPHY?

Ethnographic research is especially valuable when a researcher hopes to learn about the complexities and sticouncrasies of an environment from first-hand experience. Ethnography may be used to research organizations. communities, cultures, and other environments.
