doing it shows that a deep and interlocking civil society does not automatically lead to a rise in democratic activity Expansion of the networks of urban association could equally result in greater subdivision and to the fragmentation and isolation of certain groups Partition as much as coherence is our understanding of civil society and associations in the nineteenth century urban place
