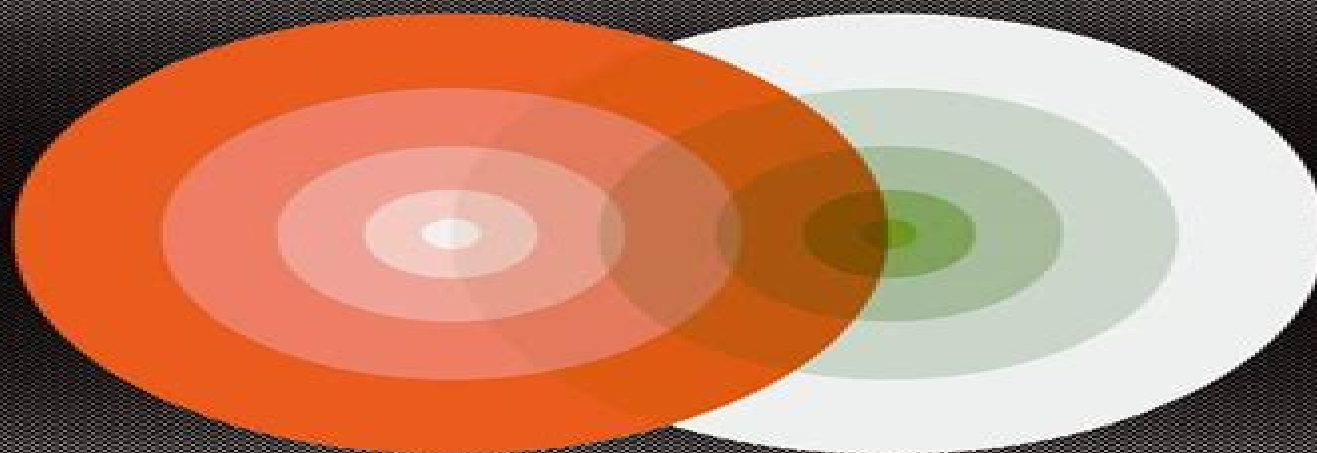

course the material on spherical waves waveguides and waves in anisotropic media may be omitted without loss of continuity
