Population density and the public's desires and expectations as well as financial requirements are among the reasons for some major city parks such as Golden Gate in San Francisco, Central Park in New York City and Lincoln Park in Chicago which integrate botanical or zoological divisions as well as museums and recreational facilities. While this book attempts to provide basic principles involved in public garden management, it does not claim to be a substitute for broader familiarity.
