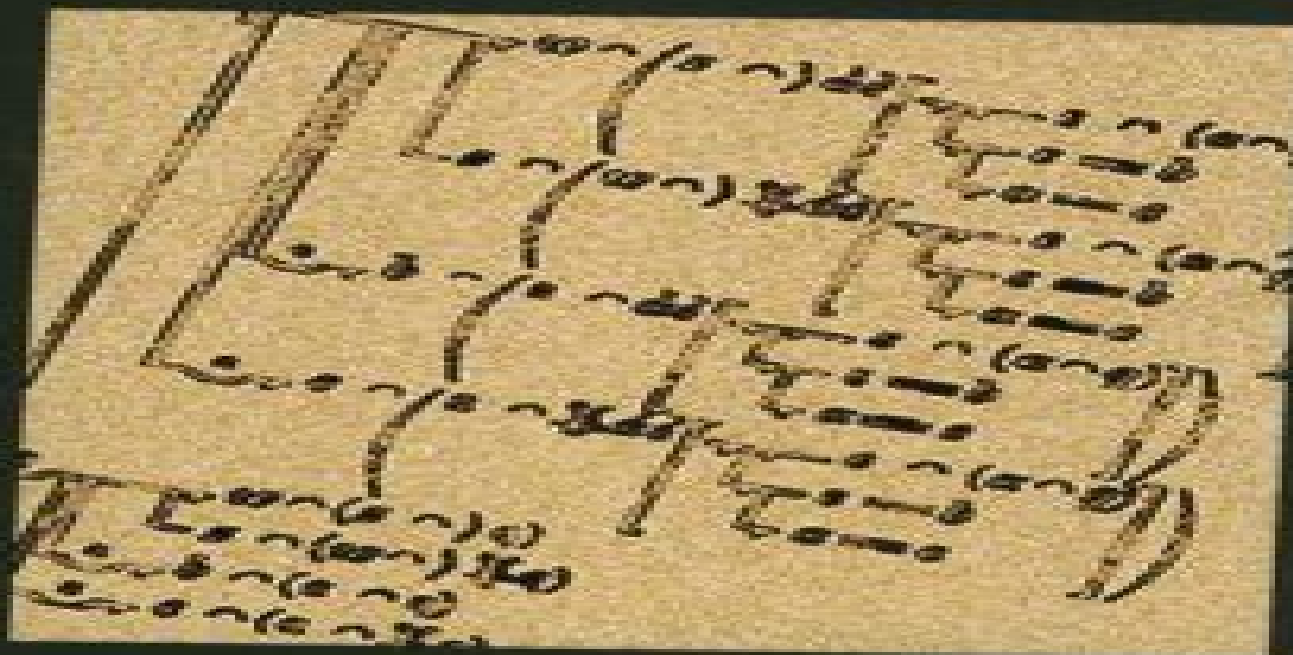

Democracy and Conflict Frederic R. Kellogg, 2023-12-15 The economist Kenneth Arrow proved in 1951 that a society of diverse individual preferences could only be ordered by dictatorship His impossibility theorem is still an axiom of contemporary welfare economics and has never been seriously challenged The American philosopher John Dewey who died in 1952 had claimed that voting and electoral mechanisms do not define democratic self government His broad conception of social conflict addresses preference diversity and resolves Arrow's impossibility Since the 1980s political scientists have focused on decision through democratic deliberation Dewey saw that conversation alone is inadequate for resolution of conflicts in a democracy Conflict is accompanied by discourse but preferences are grounded in habits Social habits resist adjustment in response to discourse alone but demonstrably adjust in the process of conflict resolution Preference conflict is distinguished from Marxist and later models as a discovery and transformation process It advances an original updated theory of social conflict in a democracy relevant to today's problematic situations from discrimination to climate change and political polarization

On the Resurrection of the Dead James T. Turner, Jr., 2018-10-03 Christian tradition has largely held three theological affirmations on the resurrection of the physical body Firstly that bodily resurrection is not a superfluous hope of afterlife Secondly there is immediate post mortem existence in Paradise Finally there is numerical identity between pre mortem and post resurrection human beings The same tradition also largely adheres to a robust doctrine of The Intermediate State a paradisiacal disembodied state of existence following the biological death of a human being This book argues that these positions are in fact internally inconsistent and so a new theological model for life after death is required The opening arguments of the book aim to show that The Intermediate State actually undermines the necessity of bodily resurrection Additionally substance dualism a principle The Intermediate State requires is shown to be equally untenable in this context In response to this the metaphysics of the afterlife in Christian theology is re evaluated and after investigating physicalist and constitutionist replacements for substance dualist metaphysics a new theory called Eschatological Presentism is put forward This model combines a broadly Thomistic hylemorphic metaphysics with a novel theory of Time This is an innovative examination of the doctrine of life after death It will therefore be of great interest to scholars of analytic theology and philosophy of religion

Stability in Postcolonial African States Emmanuel
